LENT I YEAR A

Collect

Almighty God, whose Son Jesus Christ fasted forty days in the wilderness, and was tempted as we are, yet without sin: give us grace to discipline ourselves in obedience to your Spirit; and, as you know our weakness, so may we know your power to save:

through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

FIRST READING Deuteronomy 6: 4-9

A reading from the book of Deuteronomy.

Hear, O Israel: The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart. Recite them to your children and talk about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise. Bind them as a sign on your hand, fix them as an emblem on your forehead, and write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

This is the word of the Lord.

GOSPEL Matthew 4.1-11

Hear the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Matthew.

- Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.
- He fasted forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was famished.
- The tempter came and said to him, 'If you are the Son of God, command these stones to become loaves of bread.'
- But he answered, 'It is written, "One does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God."
- Then the devil took him to the holy city and placed him on the pinnacle of the temple, saying to him,
- 'If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down; for it is written, "He will command his angels concerning you," and "On their hands they will bear you up, so that you will not dash your foot against a stone."
- Jesus said to him, 'Again it is written, "Do not put the Lord your God to the test."
- Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendour;
- and he said to him, 'All these I will give you, if you will fall down and worship me.'
- Jesus said to him, 'Away with you, Satan! for it is written, "Worship the Lord your God, and serve only him."
- Then the devil left him, and suddenly angels came and waited on him.
